- 3. Free Program

Cello: 1. Choose one from Solo suite Sarabande from No. 1,2,3,4,6 or Allemande from No.6

- 2. "La Traviata" Act 1, No. 1 Prelude (the sheet music will be provided)
- 3. Free Program

Note: There is no need to repeat on Bach program.

Free program repertoire ideally includes, but is not limited to, concertos, solo sonatas, and other repertoire with accompanists.
